

JDW- a 1975 SFChron version of an AP story out of DC on the then current releases of the CIA is quite valuable in an affidavit I've done for one of the FOIA cases. So thanks again and thought you'd like to know. The use is that in 1979 the CIA swore to the court in my C.A. 75-~~1986~~ 1448 exactly what it disclosed in 1975. ... Don't know how the judge will react, if at all. They are all inclined to accept almost any abuse by the spookeries. But I'm giving this one a heavy dose, about 10 examples from disclosed CIA records and one other news account of what they swore they had to withhold until 1978 in their late 1979 affidavit. At this stage of that case the issue is simple: does the government have to repay litigating costs. I think this makes the affidavit fraud in addition to false swearing. Best, HW 1/1/80
