Dear Mr. Weisberg:

This is in reference to our letter to you of July 23, 1975, in reply to your Freedom of Information Act request of July 9, 1975.

Enclosed are copies of the CIA letter of October 2, 1967, and the typed copies of four lists of documents referred to in that letter. Copies of the handwritten lists (19 p.) that were originally used in connection with correspondence with the CIA will be furnished to you if you want them. The information deleted from the lists in a few places is denied to you under 5 U.S.C. 552 (b) (1), matters that are "(1) (A) specifically authorized under criteria established by an Executive order to be kept secret in the interest of national defense or foreign policy and (B) are in fact properly classified."

Also enclosed are copies of pages 1, 3, and 22 of Commission Document 651 relating to Yuri Nosenko. The deleted parts of these pages and all of pages 4-7 and 11-21 of CD 651, which do not relate to Nosenko, are denied to you under 5 U.S.C. 552 (b) (7), investigatory records compiled for law enforcement purposes, the disclosure of which would (C) constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy and (D) reveal the identity of a confidential source or information furnished only by the confidential source.

You have the right to file an administrative appeal to the denials in this letter. Such an appeal should be in writing, prominently marked "Freedom of Information Appeal" and addressed to the Deputy Archivist of the United States, National Archives and Records Service, Washington, DC 20408.
