I think it would desirable to propore a progress of testimony designed to explore fully the possibility that shots came from the overpass rather than from the depository. At p. 40 of your memorandum reference is made to a rellroad crew on the tracks who said that the chois came from the depository. This may already have been done, but if it houn't I think it would be desirable to secure statements from every person on the overpess at the time of the assessination and conduct will whatever further investigation seems appropriate. 3. I would like you to give special consideration to any papers, documents, or other materials which you wish to secure from the witnesses you intend to call before the Commission and which you believe should be made exhibits to the witness! testimony.
