Radlich's official personal file shows that he

- (1) entered on duty with the Commission on December 20, 1963 as Consultant to the Commission at \$75 per day.
- (2) above employment was terminated on January 26, 1964.
- (3) on January 27, 1964 he was again appointed to the same position at \$100 per day not to extend beyond June 30, 1964.

Mr. Rankin stated (March 24, 1964) that "when he was getting together his legal staff" he requested that Redlich join him.
