

House Assassination Unit Denies Cuba Trip Slated

WASHINGTON (UPI) — A spokesman for the House Select Committee on Assassinations denied as "absolutely false" a report the panel was sending investigators to Cuba in connection with the killing of President John F. Kennedy.

"It is so palpably false that we have to make a denial," the spokesman said of a television news broadcast reporting the committee had asked for and received permission from Cuban leader Fidel Castro to send investigators to Havana.
