If they are available and you have copies could you send me a copy of each and let me know the cost so I can reimburse you.

I was very sorry to hear that Bud Fensterwald died recently, who had invited me to stay with him a year ago if I ever made it to Wash. D.C. He will be sorely missed.

Are you planning to attend the conference sponspored by $\underline{\text{Third}}$ $\underline{\text{Decade}}$? I hope to make the trip.

Have you read CD 645 about Richard Giesbrecht of Winnipeg, referred to as MP T-1? I have written an article about him for Third Decade, although since have received several FBI memos and teletypes referring to him, along with some information (including CD 645 which the FBI did not send) from Bill Adams in San Jose, CA (which he obtained from AARC.) I am awaiting several more teletypes found in the Minneapolis FBI files which have been sent to Washington for processing including a copy of one from Dallas to Headquarters about Giesbrecht. I would be interested in your views on Giesbrecht, "Isaacs", etc. (which was investigated by Boxley, Turner and Bethell for Garrison, but I can't get an explanation as to why Giesbrecht was not called to testify after all, unless it was because Ferrie could not be connected to Shaw, which Jane Rosconi suggested to me; she is head of research for Stone's upcoming movie.)
